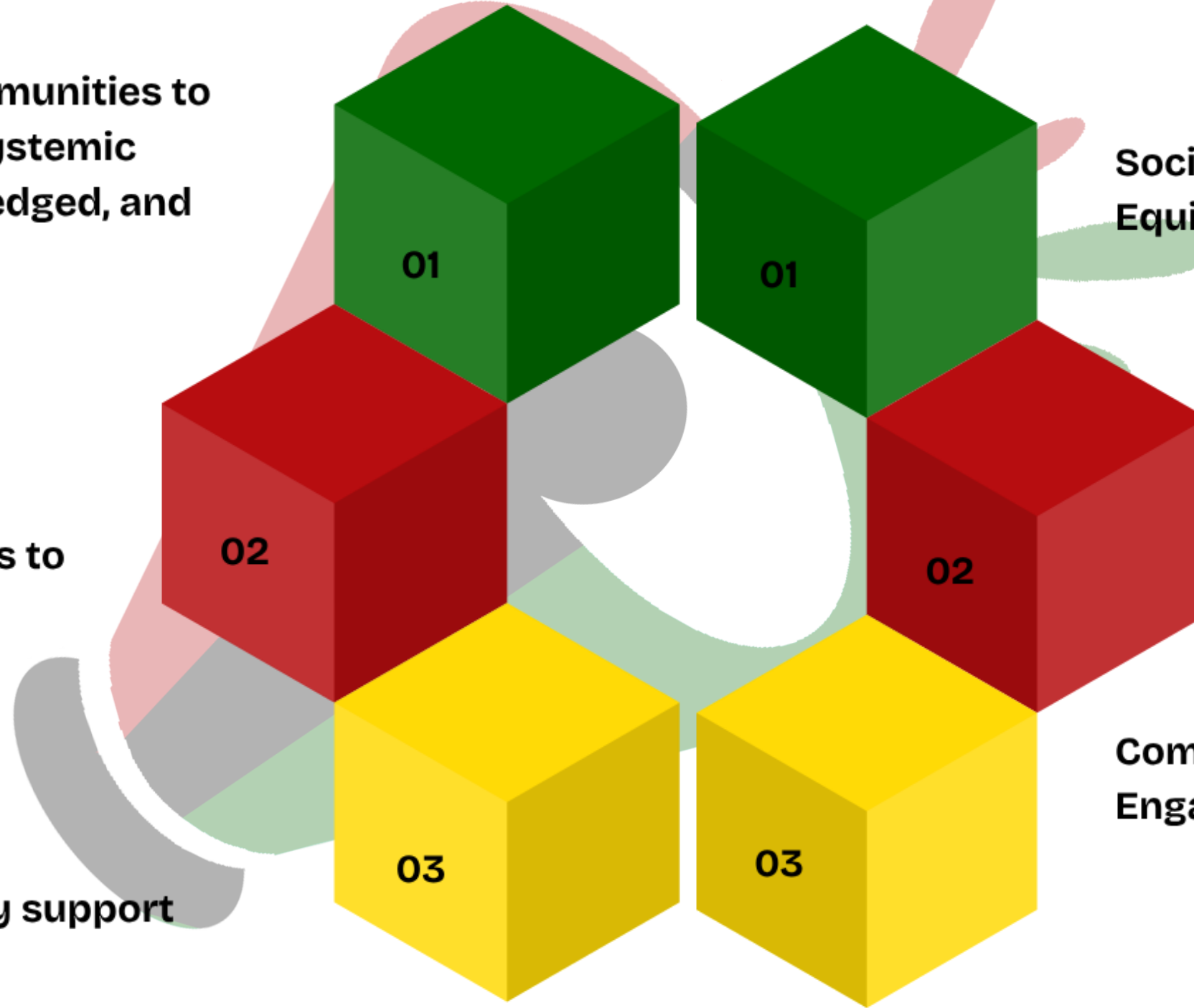

OUR STRATEGIC FOCUS:

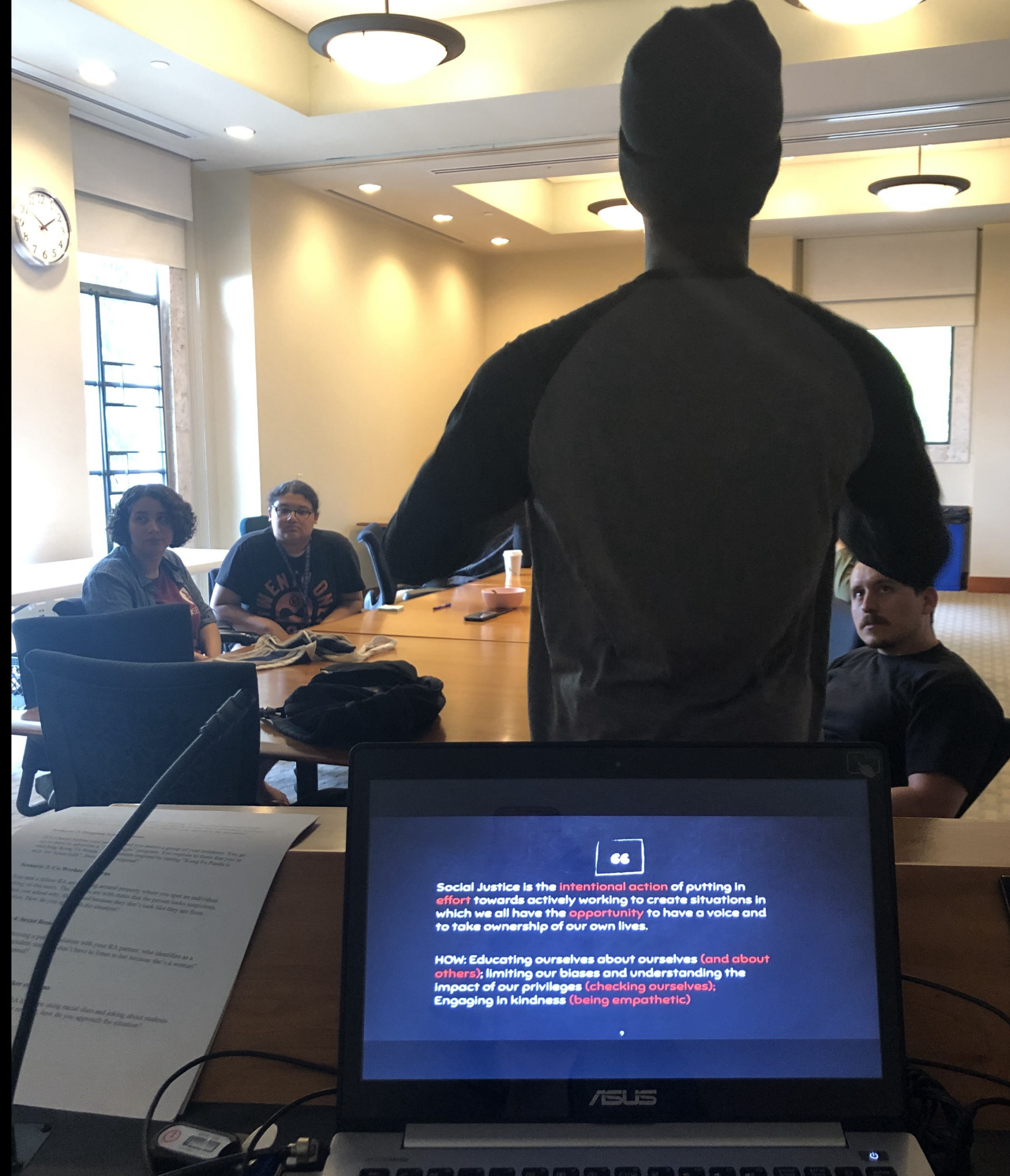
Diversity, Equity and Inclusion: Ensuring our services, resources, and activities are comprehensively promoted, easily accessible, and meet the needs of the community it serves

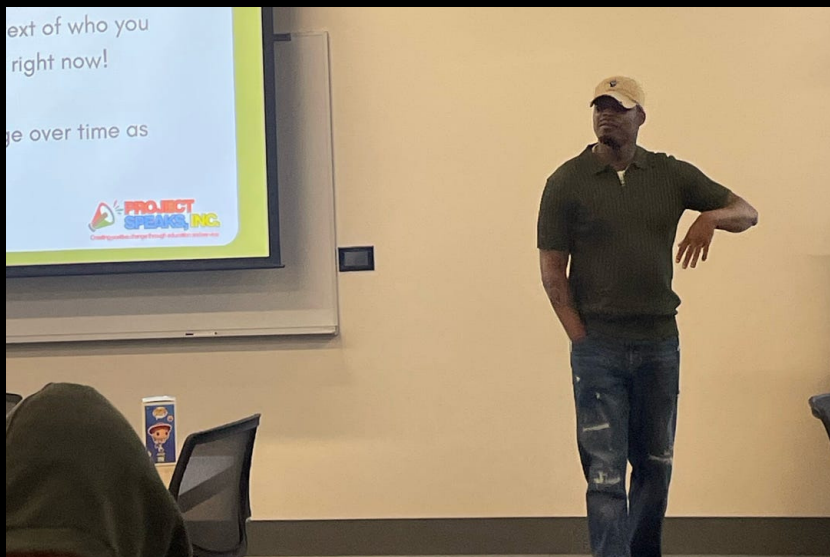
Goal 2: By 2030, create resource packet with local and national resources for community members
